

Fundraising with Scrip/Raise Right



Enrollment Information

Visit Shopwithscrip.com and register for a new account using Enrollment Code **7F531BF14331**.

Once you enroll you will need to add your personal bank account so you can place orders. If you choose not to add a personal bank account, a check must be given to the Scrip Coordinator before your order is released.

Using a web browser, log in to your new account. Next to your name, near the top right corner, click the drop down and navigate to Account Settings.




Make sure you fill out all of your information, including your student's name. That is how the treasurer will know who to assign the earnings to, if you and your student do not share the same last name.

After your account information is updated, use the menu on the left and expand Family Functions, and click Payment Types. This is the screen where you can set up the link to your bank account.
